

ABC's of Sporting Clays Safety

- Keep your muzzle pointed in a safe direction at all times. No need to pick up hulls; they are the property of the club once they hit the ground.
- Action should always remain open, empty and exposed to view until ready to shoot.
- Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- No loading until you are in your shooting station. Your safety should remain on at all times when you are out of your shooting station.
- Keep your gun pointed down range at all times.
- Never move from a station with a loaded gun.
- No more than 2 rounds are allowed in your gun even if you are shooting doubles.
- If your gun jams/malfunctions STOP USING and use a teammate's gun.
- Please dispose of misfired shotgun shells in the 5 gallon buckets at the shooting site.
- No high base loads or shot sizes larger than 7 ½.
- Eye and hearing protection are required.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed until you are done shooting for the day.
